

Luncheon Speaker - Dr. Clyde McCoy

Clyde B. McCoy, Ph.D. has served the University of Miami in various capacities for more than three decades. He holds the position of Professor, Chairman Emeritus of Epidemiology & Public Health at UM, as well as Director of the Comprehensive Drug Research Center. He is a founding member of both the FL Institute of Public Health and Miami Dade Public Health Institute and has directed the drug-abuse research facility at UM ever since it opened in 1974. Dr. McCoy has been involved in UM athletics for almost as long; as Faculty Athletic Representative for UM athletics, Dr. McCoy has been responsible for ensuring academic integrity, facilitating institutional control of intercollegiate athletics and enhancing the student-athlete experience. During his tenure at the University he has established a successful career and international reputation in research, teaching and administration. Dr. McCoy's research interests include a broad span of epidemiology, substance abuse, cancer, early detection of breast cancer, HIV-AIDS, community studies, health planning, and health services. He has been published in several journals on these topics and recognized both for his scholarship and leadership. Dr. McCoy has over 300 publications with over 200 scientists including articles in leading journals. Most recently, Dr. McCoy was elected to serve as President of the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). As President, his goals include making sure that student athletes receive top-notch educations, as well as recognizing where the organization is, relative to a business model. We are truly honored to have Dr. McCoy speak before the Tribe as we celebrate the University and our Fall 2009 Tapping class.
